

## **A Scientific Welsh Eye Surgeon:**

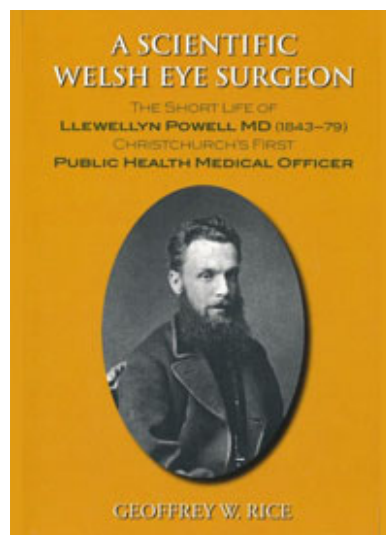
The short life of Llewellyn Powell MD (1843-79)

Written by Geoffrey Rice, this is a biography of Christchurch's first Medical Officer of Health and an important public health pioneer in New Zealand. Powell was also a significant biological scientist, an authority on New Zealand spiders, and was secretary to the Philosophical Institute and the Acclimatisation Society. He died far too young, at 36, probably from TB.
